THE DRAFT TEST

The NCA Draft Test is a series of exercises designed to develop and demonstrate the natural abilities of purebred Newfoundland Dogs. While working in a capacity involving hauling, the dog and handler must demonstrate teamwork skills. The Newfoundland has historically functioned as a draft dog in various capacities, and the performance of these exercises is intended to demonstrate skills resulting both from natural ability and training that are applicable to realistic work situations.

The dogs must be willing to work with their handlers and the exercises must be accomplished efficiently. The goal of each handler is to maintain control while encouraging his dogs' natural independence; together, they demonstrate teamwork.

ENTRIES

Entries on Saturday, November 6, will be limited to 4 BDD, 5 DD/TDD and 3 DDX for a total of 12 entries. If there are fewer than 3 DDX entries, the remaining slots may be filled with BDD, DD/TDD entries. Entries on Sunday, November 7, will be limited to 4 BDD, 5 DD/TDD and 3 DDX for a total of 12 entries. If less than 5 total entries, PONC reserves the right to cancel the test and fully refund all entry fees. This test will not accept post entry of teams. Priority will be given to entries that have not earned titles in the division entered. Entries from within the United States will be accepted by U.S.P.S. Mail ONLY. Foreign entries must show a verifiable mailing date. In order to ensure that your entry has a legible postmark date, it is suggested that you request that your entry be hand-stamped at the post office (you may be charged an additional fee). If you use Express Mail, you MUST waive the signature.

No entries from NCA members will be accepted with a postmark prior to October 8, 2021. No entries from NON NCA members will be accepted with a postmark prior to October 18, 2021.

All entries must be submitted on an NCA entry form, including a copy of the dog's current AKC, CKC, PAL, ILP or foreign registration with a legible number. A separate entry for Saturday and Sunday is required if you plan on entering both days. Entry slots will be filled according to postmark date. In the event that the number of entries with the same postmark date received exceeds the limit, vacancies will be filled and alternates will be determined by a random drawing for each day. Entries received after the entry limit has been reached will be placed on an alternate list in order of postmark. Alternates will be notified immediately should an opening occur.

Exhibitors Note

This Draft Test will be judged under the NCA Draft Test Regulations effective March 18, 1994 as updated April, 2019 and effective July, 2019, and NCA DDX Test Regulations effective 2015 as updated April, 2019. Entrants are responsible for knowledge of these regulations. A copy of the regulations can be or downloaded from the NCA website at http://www.newfdogclub.org.

Dogs Eligible to Compete

The NCA Draft Tests will be open to purebred Newfoundland dogs at least eighteen months of age. The word 'dog' in the NCA Draft Test Regulations refers to either sex. All entered dogs must have an AKC registration number, ILP or PAL number, foreign registration number, or AKC or foreign litter number.

BITCHES IN SEASON may participate in NCA Draft Tests. Bitches in season will be tested at the end of the competition after all male dogs are judged. When not being tested, bitches in season must be contained in a designated area well away from male dogs and the official test areas.

DOGS NOT BEING TESTED AT THE TIME are not permitted in the official Draft Test Areas. As specified in the Draft Test Regulations, 90 minutes before the start of judging, handlers and dogs (except bitches in season) are allowed a 30-minute period to familiarize themselves with the test area. Handlers may walk with their dogs on lead but not hitched to an apparatus. Handlers will not be permitted to walk the Maneuvering or Distance Freight Haul courses after this time period.

UNENTERED DOGS (except bitches in season) are welcome to join us at the test site. Please remember that all unentered dogs must remain well away from the main test area during judging so as not to disturb any competing dogs.

VERIFICATION OF ENTRY RECEIPT

All entrants will receive an email confirmation of receipt of their entry. Those without email will receive confirmation by USPS mail. You are also welcome to call the Test Secretary at 412-974-5249 for confirmation or questions.

Awards

Each entrant will receive a hospitality gift for participating in our test. Each qualifier will receive a gift selected by the Draft Test Committee.

SPECIAL AWARDS - SATURDAY AND SUNDAY

JUNIOR HANDLER AWARD – To encourage junior participation in Working Dog events, David and Rhoda Hartmann will offer a \$25 gift certificate to any handler under 20 years of age completing the Draft Test or to anyone under 20 years of age who work on the tests as a steward or volunteer.

PONC Safety Observances

Dogs must be crated or on leash at all times.

When on leash, the length of the leash must not exceed SIX feet and may NOT be a retractable leash.

When on leash, dogs must be under control at all times.

Dogs showing uncontrolled or aggressive behavior will be asked by the event chair, a board member, safety officer or other official to leave the site promptly or be crated for the duration of the event.

Site Description

NEO Retreat Center is a church camp that has 173 acres and 35 miles of hiking trails. The test site is composed of varied terrain, including grassy areas, wooded paths, paved areas and shade trees. The site has a shelter containing 3 rooms. There is electric and air conditioning and a raised stone fireplace against the north wall in the meeting room. There is an attached 25 by 50 gravel floor pavilion with picnic benches and approximately 30-40 plastic chairs. The ground slopes away from the facility to the west and south with a large level area to the south of the pavilion and a smaller fairly level area to the west of the shelter. The area behind the shelter is level and goes back to the tree line.

The maneuvering course will utilize natural and manmade obstacles such as trees, fences and barrels. The basic control ring will be held on a flat grassy area. Natural distractions include rabbits, squirrels, ground hogs, deer and wild turkey.

Directions

From West: Take I-76 East to State Rte 534 (exit #54). Go south approximately 4 miles. Turn right onto Shillings Road. Go approximately $\frac{1}{2}$ mile and turn right into NEO Retreat Center.

From East: Take I-80 west which will merge with I-76 west. Proceed 4 miles after the merger to State Rte 534 (exit #54). Go south approximately 4 miles. Turn right onto Shillings Road. Go approximately ½ mile and turn right into NEO Retreat Center.

From Ohio Turnpike: Exit the turnpike at I-80 and go west to the Rte 534/Newton Falls exit. Follow the directions from the east above.

Canton and South: Take State Rte 225 to State Rte 534, turn north and go approx.. 2 miles north to Shilling Road. Turn left. Go approximately $\frac{1}{2}$ mile and turn right into NEO Retreat Center.

Accommodations

RV and travel trailer camping are available at the NEO Retreat Center with water and electric hook-ups. Units must be self-contained. No dumping allowed. Bathroom and shower facilities are available on the grounds. Cabins are no longer available. Contact John Davis at 567-674-2010 for more information.

I (we) agree that any violation of the AKC Coe of Sportsmanship, the NCA Code of Ethics and/or the Judges Code of Ethics will be handled pursuant to the Grievance policies listed on the NCA website.

I (we) hereby assume the sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify and save the aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expense (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damage because of bodily injuries, including death at any time, resulting therefrom, sustained by any person or persons, including myself (ourselves) or on account of damage to property, or my vehicle arising out of or in consequence of my (our) participation in this test, howsoever such injuries, death or damage to property may be caused, ad whether or not the same may have been caused or may be alleged to have been caused by negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees or agents, or other persons.
