Certification & Regulations:

These Newfoundland Water Tests are sanctioned by the Working Dog Committee (WDC) of the Newfoundland Club of America and sponsored by the Penn-Ohio Newfoundland Club and all tests will follow the NCA's Water Test Regulations copyright 1999, revised February 1, 2026, and effective February 19, 2026. Entrants are responsible for obtaining and reading the regulations governing NCA Water Tests. A copy of the official Water Test Regulations may be found on line at <https://www.ncanewfs.org>

The Water Rescue Test

The NCA Water Tests are a series of exercises designed to develop and demonstrate the abilities of purebred Newfoundland dogs in an aquatic environment. NCA water tests demonstrate natural ability and skills acquired through training, and emphasize teamwork between dog and handler in simulated work and rescue situations. The ideal working relationship is a balance of controlled performance and natural independence. Dogs should display not only efficiency in accomplishing their tasks, but also willingness and enjoyment in their work.

Site Description:

The test is held at Pymatuning State Park made up of approximately 10 acres adjacent to the Dam. Included are two beaches, a wooded area, a park pavilion, and a large grassy area. The woods are within 60 feet of the water's edge on the left side of the site and within 30-40 feet on the right side of the site. The test site has a sand and gravel beach approximately 100 feet wide and 10-15 feet deep with a grassy area between the beach and woods. Water depth increases gradually as you move in to the lake. The lakebed slopes from left to right as you face the lake and is mostly sand and rock near shore, changing to rocks or mud 20-30 feet from shore. At normal water levels, dogs begin to swim 15-20 feet from shore on the left and 10-15 feet from shore on the right of the site. The water becomes cloudy as dogs enter but quickly clears. The site has experienced strong breezes in the past, usually blowing left to right, but occasionally swinging directly to shore. Very strong winds have produced white cap waves of 3-12 inches in height.

Exhibitors Notes

All exhibitors present at this event must be prepared to provide proof of vaccinations for all dogs present at the test site if requested by Pennsylvania State Parks personnel. If a license is required in its home state, owners must be prepared to present to Park personnel.

EACH EXHIBITOR IS RESPONSIBLE FOR PROVIDING HIS/HER OWN WATER TEST EQUIPMENT, INCLUDING A U.S. COAST GUARD APPROVED PERSONAL FLOTATION DEVICE AND SUITABLE FOOT PROTECTION TO BE WORN IN THE WATER.

NCA & PONC Safety Observances will follow NCA Policy on Out of Control Dog & Dog Aggression, NCA BOD approved 2023.11.11:



1. At all NCA Events dogs must be kept under control to prevent harm to itself or others. It is the owner/handler's responsibility to ensure their dogs are under control for the duration of the event.
2. Dogs must be crated or leashed and collared at all times, except when the dogs are required to perform off leash.
3. When on leash, the length of the leash must not exceed SIX feet and may NOT be a retractable leash.
4. Dogs should not be allowed to approach another dog without permission from the other dog's owner/handler.
5. Any dog that, in the opinion of the judges, event committee or designated safety officer representing the event, appears dangerous, shall be asked to leave the event promptly or be crated for the duration of the event and is excused from further participation in the event. Anyone who witnesses a dog appearing to be dangerous should bring their concerns to the judges, event committee or safety officer. Part of upholding good sportsmanship is to take action through the appropriate channels.

Examples of out of control behavior would include but are not limited to:

Aggressive vocalization such as barking and growling, or aggressive behavior toward any person or animal such as snapping, biting, lunging, charging, attacking or attempting to attack at any time while on the test grounds.

6. Dogs or handlers suspended from AKC are unable to enter NCA events and dogs suspended from AKC events are not allowed on test ground.
7. Owners and handlers are responsible for monitoring the well-being and safety of their dog(s). If left unattended the owner/handler must check on them frequently to ensure they are safe.
8. If the dog is excused from the test grounds for aggression, the automatic grievance policy of the NCA is enacted. If an injury to a dog or person occurs, the AKC Rules Applying to Dog Shows Ch 11, section 15 goes into effect. (References, chapter 2, section 14 in both water and draft regulations)

Dogs Eligible to Compete:

The NCA Water Rescue Tests will be open to purebred Newfoundland dogs at least six (6) months of age. The word 'dog' in the NCA Water Rescue Test Regulations refers to either sex. All entered dogs must have an AKC/CKC registration number, AKC ILP/PAL number, foreign registration number, or AKC or foreign litter number.

Bitches In Season or with Ovarian Sparing Spay:

Bitches in season or ovarian sparing spay will not be allowed on the test site until just prior to being judged, which will be after all other dogs are tested. When not being tested, bitches in season must be contained in a designated area away from the official test areas. If you are entering a bitch, do you anticipate she might be in season? As a courtesy, please inform the Test Chairperson or Secretary in advance.

Dogs not being tested at the time are not permitted in the official Test Areas during designated testing times.

Spectators & Unentered Dogs:

Spectators and unentered dogs (bitches in season, see above), are welcome at the PONC Water Test. Unentered dogs will not be permitted in the official Test Areas for the duration of the judging day. Once all awards are distributed the site is open to all. As a courtesy to our exhibitors, we ask that all dogs be kept quiet and leashed or crated.

Photography & Release:

The photographers on site are spectators and volunteers. They have many other duties in addition to recording the PONC test for the club. They are NOT required nor expected to take photos of all dogs, divisions, exercises, or awards. If exhibitors or others want to ensure that photos are taken of their dog(s) during the test weekend, please designate a person to use your cell phone or other recording device.

If YOU have a preference to NOT be photographed or in the PROXIMITY of any photographer during your exhibition, please notify the Test Chair PRIOR to your testing.

**Use of images and publishing of results:**

By entering this event, you hereby give your consent to publish and/or alter any and all photos and/or videos (hereby referred to as Images) taken of you or your dog(s) that are present during this event, whether they are entered as exhibitors or not, and you agree to waive any claim, action, lawsuit and further agree to indemnify and hold NCA, the host club, and any Judge harmless from claims, actions or lawsuit resulting from the use of these images and your participation in this event.

Results of the event, whether dogs passed or failed, the names of dogs, the names of handlers, the names of owners, and/or the names of breeders may also be published. Use of and publishing may be in any printed format, including but not limited to: email, websites, and/or social media.

Verification of Entry Receipt

Online entrants will receive an automatic email notification on submission.

USPS entrants will receive email notification once the test secretary has received and transcribed their entry to the online system. USPS entries will be entered by their postmark date, not the date received to the online system. If submitting by USPS be sure to have the Post Master stamp your envelope legibly. No entries requiring a signature for delivery will be accepted. No, USPS entries received after close regardless of postmark will be accepted.

Any entrant may request confirmation of receipt of their entry by either enclosing a self addressed stamped postcard with their entry or supplying an e-mail address. You may also email newfiestuff4ann@gmail.com for confirmation of receipt.

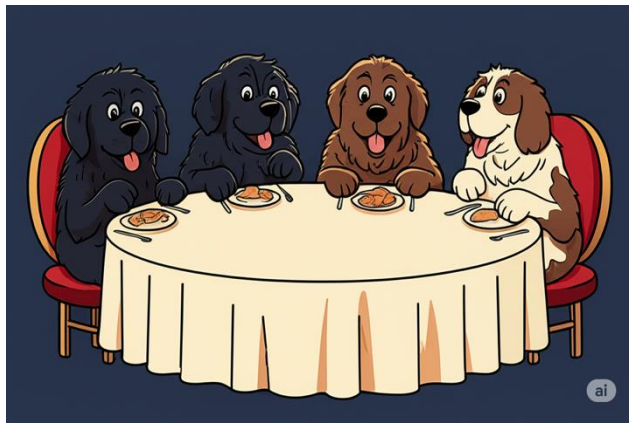

ENTRIES are limited by day and division with a minimum entry of 5 required on each day. Entries submitted electronically will be assigned a postmark with the same date the entry is entered. Entries submitted by mail will be assigned the postmark given as per the USPS postmark. Entries submitted electronically and via post will be considered equally in date order for slots in the test. NCA members will have the same early-entry window with both paper entry and electronic entry.

If you are not a member of the NCA you will be prompted to provide the same contact information that you would provide on a paper entry once entries are open to non-NCA members. You will be prompted to enter or verify your dog's information, and you will have the opportunity to upload an image of your dog's registration certificate. Please have an electronic version of your dog's registration certificate ready for upload before you begin the online entry process. Entry slots will be filled according to postmark date. If the number of entries with the same postmark date received exceeds the limit, vacancies will be filled and alternates will be determined by a random drawing for each day. Entries received after the entry limit has been reached will be placed on an alternate list in order of postmark. Alternates will be notified immediately should an opening occur.

Directions to Pymatuning State Park, Dam Road, Shelter #2, Jamestown, PA

Major North/South routes are I -79, US Route 19, OH 11 and PA 58 via PA 18

From I -80 and I -79 Northbound: Take PA 358 West exit to Greenville, PA. Take PA 58 West to Jamestown, Merge to US 322 West in Jamestown. Stay on US 322 West approx 2miles to a right turn into Pymatuning State Park. Make an immediate right onto Dam Road, cross the dam to test site on left.

From I -79 Southbound: Take US 322 and Route 6 exit at Meadville, PA. Stay on US 322 West into Jamestown, PA. Stay on US 322 West approx. 2miles to a right turn into Pymatuning State Park. Make an immediate right onto Dam Road, cross the dam to test site on left.

From OH 11: Exit OH 11 at US 322 East. Follow US 322 East into PA. Approx 1mile past the Shangri-La Campground (on Left) take the second left into Pymatuning State Park. Make an immediate right onto Dam Road, cross the dam to test site on left.

From PA 58 via PA 18: Enter Greenville, PA on PA 18, merge with PA 58 West. Follow PA 58 West into Jamestown, PA. Merge to US 322 West in Jamestown, PA. Stay on US 322 West approx 2miles to right turn into Pymatuning State Park. Make an immediate right onto Dam Road, cross the dam to test site on left.
